NEW BUSINESS

Morristown Elementary PTA written request for \$2,500 to help with funds lost due to effects of COVID and no fundraising allowed. Council Member Larry Tracy made a motion to approve \$3,000 for the PTA and this motion as seconded by Council Member Ralph Henderson. Vote 5/0
