August 14, 2019

OLD BUSINESS:

Cost of Use Study:

John Seever from Baker-Tilley presented the results of the cost of use study. As a result of the study costs will shift from residential to non-residential type users with industrial type users picking up more of the cost. New rates are scheduled to go in effect around the first of 2020. A motion by Council Member David Benefiel to go with the new rate structure. Council Member Ralph Henderson seconded the motion. Motion passed. Vote 4/0

Mitchell Eschweiler from Baker-Tilley went over the 2018 Financial Review for both the Morristown Water and Morristown Municipal Wastewater Utility.
